**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR A BRIDGE AND WALKWAY AT THE WILTON TRAIN STATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 \_\_\_\_ dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Department of
- 5 Transportation for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the town
- 6 of Wilton to construct a pedestrian bridge and paved walkway to
- 7 integrate the Wilton train station, bus transit and downtown area.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To authorize bonds of the state to provide greater access to mass transit and to increase commercial activity around the Wilton train station.
