**AN ACT RESTRICTING THE USE OF CERTAIN CHEMICALS THAT ARE HARMFUL TO JUVENILE LOBSTERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) No person shall  
2 introduce malathion (O,O-dimethyl phosphorodithioate of diethyl  
3 mercapto-succinate) or methoprene (Isopropyl (2E-4E)-11-methoxy-  
4 3,7,11-trimethyl-2,4-dodecadienoate) into any waterway of the state or  
5 into any catch basin or storm drain.
- 6 (b) Any person who wilfully violates any provision of subsection (a)  
7 of this section shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
