AN ACT CONCERNING BONDING TO BENEFIT REDEMPTION SONG, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 two million seven hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which
- 5 shall be used by the Department of Mental Health and Addiction
- 6 Services for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to Redemption
- 7 Song, Inc. of Wallingford.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve recovery rates and maintain family connections by allocating bond funds for the acquisition or rental of supportive sober housing for parents attending the Dry Dock recovery program in Wallingford.
