AN ACT CONCERNING REGISTERED INTERIOR DESIGNERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 20-377s of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
3 *1, 2012*):

4 (b) No person shall: (1) Present or attempt to present, as his own, the
5 certificate of another, (2) knowingly give false evidence of a material
6 nature to the commissioner for the purpose of procuring a certificate,
7 (3) use or attempt to use a certificate which has expired or which has
8 been suspended or revoked, or (4) represent himself falsely as, or
9 impersonate, a registered interior designer. [, or (5) include his
10 certificate number as a part of any advertisement or represent in any
11 manner that his certificate of registration constitutes an endorsement
12 of the quality of his workmanship or of his competency by the
13 commissioner.]

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To remove an outdated restriction placed on registered interior designers.
