AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF "NOTARIAL ACT".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (3) of section 3-94a of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2012*):

4 (3) "Notarial act" or "notarization" means any act that a notary
5 public is empowered to perform under the general statutes and
6 includes taking an acknowledgment, administering an oath or
7 affirmation, witnessing or attesting a signature and certifying or
8 attesting a copy.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
