AN ACT CONCERNING THE DELIVERY OF SOCIAL SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 17b-342 of the 2012 supplement to the general
2 statutes is amended by adding subsection (l) as follows (*Effective July 1,*
3 *2012*):

4 (NEW) (l) (1) The access agency selected in accordance with
5 subsection (b) of this section shall process registrations from adult day
6 care providers who have been certified by the Connecticut Association
7 of Adult Day Centers not later than thirty days after such providers
8 register with the access agency;

9 (2) The access agency shall not require that any day care provider
10 register more than once notwithstanding any distinct services such
11 provider offers;

12 (3) The access agency shall deliver such qualified provider names to
13 the Department of Social Services not later than thirty days after such
14 provider registers;

15 (4) Not later than thirty days after receipt of provider names from
16 the access agency, the Commissioner of Social Services shall include
17 such names on a list of state providers eligible for Medicaid
18 reimbursement under the Connecticut home care program for the
19 elderly.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the number of day care providers eligible to receive Medicaid reimbursement under the Connecticut home care program for the elderly.
