**AN ACT CONCERNING PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS DURING A CIVIL PREPAREDNESS EMERGENCY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2012*) Notwithstanding the  
2 provisions of section 12-146 of the general statutes, no installment of  
3 property tax shall be considered delinquent if such installment was  
4 due during the existence of a civil preparedness emergency  
5 proclaimed by the Governor pursuant to section 28-9 of the general  
6 statutes, provided such installment is paid in full not later than five  
7 business days following the day on which the Governor proclaims the  
8 end of the civil preparedness emergency.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
