**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF A COMMUNITY CENTER AND RECREATIONAL
FACILITY IN NEW LONDON.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 eight million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Department of Economic and Community Development for the
- 6 purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to construct a community center
- 7 and recreational facility in New London.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize bond funds to construct a community center and recreational facility in New London.
