**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY ON THE LABOR DEPARTMENT'S
WAIVER OF WEEKLY PAY REQUIREMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Labor Department shall study
2 issues concerning the waiver of the weekly pay requirement pursuant
3 to section 31-71i of the general statutes and the results of a
4 modification to such waiver that would require employees to be paid
5 in full by an employer at least twice in each calendar month. Not later
6 than January 1, 2013, the Labor Commissioner shall report on such
7 study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
8 cognizance of matters relating to labor in accordance with the
9 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Labor Department to study the effects of requiring employers to pay employees in full at least twice each calendar month.
