**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR DEVELOPMENT  
OF A STEM CURRICULUM IN MIDDLE SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 five million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Department of Education for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid
- 6 to municipalities for the development of science, technology,
- 7 engineering and mathematics curriculum in middle schools, as well as
- 8 the purchase of related equipment, software and supplies for such
- 9 curriculum.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide funds in the amount of five million dollars for the development of a science, technology, engineering and mathematics curriculum in middle schools.
