**AN ACT CONCERNING REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICE CENTERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 10-221d of the 2012 supplement  
2 to the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in  
3 lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

4 (b) If a local or regional board of education, endowed or  
5 incorporated academy approved by the State Board of Education  
6 pursuant to section 10-34, or special education facility approved by the  
7 State Board of Education pursuant to section 10-76d requests, a  
8 regional educational service center shall arrange for the fingerprinting  
9 of any person required to submit to state and national criminal history  
10 records checks pursuant to this section or for conducting any other  
11 method of positive identification required by the State Police Bureau of  
12 Identification or the Federal Bureau of Investigation and shall forward  
13 such fingerprints or other positive identifying information to the State  
14 Police Bureau of Identification which shall conduct criminal history  
15 records checks in accordance with section 29-17a. Such regional  
16 educational service center shall maintain such fingerprints or other

17 positive identifying information for a period of four years, at the end  
18 of which such fingerprints and positive identifying information shall  
19 be destroyed, and may maintain such fingerprints in an electronic  
20 format. Such regional educational service centers shall provide the  
21 results of such checks to such local or regional board of education,  
22 endowed or incorporated academy or special education facility. Such  
23 regional educational service centers shall provide such results to any  
24 other local or regional board of education or regional educational  
25 service center upon the request of such person.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require regional educational service centers to maintain fingerprints and other positive identifying information for a period of four years.
