**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF REMANUFACTURED PARTS FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF THE STATE'S MOTOR VEHICLE FLEET.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 4a-67d of the general statutes is amended by  
2 adding subsection (j) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2012*):

3 (NEW) (j) In performing the requirements of this section, the  
4 Commissioners of Administrative Services, Motor Vehicles and  
5 Transportation may use recycled, remanufactured or aftermarket parts  
6 as the primary means of maintenance and repair of any vehicle in the  
7 state fleet when available and when there is a demonstrated cost  
8 savings over the life of the vehicle, provided the requirements of this  
9 subsection shall not apply to any fleet vehicle under the management  
10 of the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
