**AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (15) of subsection (a) of section 9-7b of the  
2 2012 supplement to the general statutes is repealed and the following  
3 is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

4 (15) To the extent that the State Elections Enforcement Commission  
5 is involved in the investigation of alleged or suspected criminal  
6 violations of any provision of the general statutes pertaining to or  
7 relating to any such election, primary or referendum and is engaged in  
8 such investigation for the purpose of presenting evidence to the Chief  
9 State's Attorney, the State Elections Enforcement Commission shall be  
10 deemed a law enforcement agency for purposes of subdivision (3) of  
11 subsection (b) of section 1-210, provided nothing in this section shall be  
12 construed to exempt the State Elections Enforcement Commission in  
13 any other respect from the requirements of the Freedom of Information  
14 Act, as defined in section 1-200;

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
