"AN ACT CONCERNING PLANNING REGIONS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 4-89 of the 2012 supplement to
4 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2012*):

6 (a) No officer, department, board, commission, institution or other
7 agency of the state shall, after the close of any fiscal year, incur, or vote
8 or order or approve the incurring of, any obligation or expenditure
9 under any appropriation made by the General Assembly for any fiscal
10 year that had expired at the time the obligation for such expenditure
11 was incurred. The Comptroller is authorized to draw warrants or
12 process interdepartmental transactions against the available
13 appropriations made for the current fiscal year for the payment of

14 expenditures incurred during the prior fiscal year for which
15 appropriations were made or in fulfillment of contracts properly made
16 during such prior year, and the Treasurer is authorized to pay such
17 warrants or record such interdepartmental transactions. The balances
18 of certain appropriations which otherwise would lapse at the close of
19 any fiscal year and for which no appropriation is made in the
20 following year shall be extended into the succeeding fiscal year for a
21 period of one month to permit liquidation of obligations of the prior
22 fiscal year."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
