## "AN ACT REVISING THE PENALTY FOR CAPITAL FELONIES."

- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and 2 internal references accordingly:
- "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective from passage) (a) Notwithstanding the 3 provisions of this act, any person convicted of murder with special 4 5 circumstances under subdivision (8) of section 53a-54b of the general 6 statutes, as amended by this act, for the murder of a person under 7 sixteen years of age, committed on or after the effective date of this 8 section, shall be sentenced to a term of life imprisonment without the 9 possibility of release unless a sentence of death is imposed in the 10 manner prescribed in section 53a-46a of the general statutes, as 11 amended by this act.
- 12 (b) The provisions of this act applicable to a person who commits a 13 capital felony prior to the effective date of this section shall apply in 14 like manner to a person convicted of murder as provided in subsection 15 (a) of this section."
