"AN ACT CONCERNING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY HEALTH CARE FOR UNINSURED CHILDREN."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Insurance Commissioner
4 shall request from each insurer licensed and doing business in this
5 state information regarding any records of slaveholder insurance
6 policies that were issued by such insurer or any predecessor company
7 prior to 1849 and provided coverage for damage to or death of the
8 slaveholder's slaves.

9 (b) Each insurer shall research its records and report its findings to
10 the commissioner not later than September 1, 2012. If the insurer
11 possesses or has knowledge of any such records, it shall include in its
12 report the number of such records and the names of any slaveholders
13 and slaves described in such records.

14 (c) Not later than January 1, 2013, the commissioner shall submit a
15 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
16 statutes, of the information submitted to the commissioner pursuant to
17 subsection (b) of this section, to the joint standing committee of the
18 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to insurance."
