"AN ACT CONCERNING PRESCRIPTION DRUG MONITORING."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 20-10c of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2012*):

5 Any person who practices medicine for no fee [] for at least one
6 hundred hours per year at a public health facility, as defined in section
7 20-126*l*, or in connection with (1) a mobile health clinic that provides
8 health care services to individuals of this state, (2) a local health
9 department, (3) the United States Department of Veterans Affairs'
10 Veterans Health Administration, (4) a United States Coast Guard
11 medical clinic, or (5) Doctors Without Borders and does not otherwise
12 engage in the practice of medicine, shall be eligible to renew a license,
13 as provided in subsection (b) of section 19a-88, without payment of the
14 professional services fee specified in said subsection (b)."
