**"AN ACT CONCERNING PHOSPHOROUS REDUCTION IN STATE WATERS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective October 1, 2012*) Not later than February 1, 2013,  
4 the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection, in  
5 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,  
6 shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the General  
7 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment on  
8 any private or public source of revenue that may be available for the  
9 purpose of remediating the Raymark Superfund site in the town of  
10 Stratford. Such report shall include, but not be limited to, a listing of  
11 such sources of revenue, the amount of funds potentially available  
12 from such sources of revenue, the requirements for obtaining funding

13 from such sources of revenue, the department's recommendations  
14 concerning the pursuit of such sources of revenue, the reasons for such  
15 recommendations and a proposed timeline for pursuing funding from  
16 any such sources."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Sec. 501	<i>October 1, 2012</i>	New section
