Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE REVISION OF MUNICIPAL CHARTERS.

Statement of Purpose: To provide that after October 1, 2012, charter commissions, charter revision commissions and home rule ordinance revision commissions may only consider changes to charters and home rule ordinances recommended by the appointing authority or by petition unless a charter or home rule ordinance has not been comprehensively reviewed in twelve or more years.
