Title: AN ACT CONCERNING "ZAPPERS".

Statement of Purpose: To make it a felony to sell, purchase, install, transfer or possess an automated sales suppression device ("zapper") or phantom-ware that eliminates point-of-sale transactions randomly, and creates a shadow record of the sale, making it difficult to detect understated records of sales and sales tax liability.
