**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING STREAM CHANNEL ENCROACHMENT LINES AND PERMITS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To minimize any adverse affects of state regulations on business, to streamline and expedite the state permitting and regulatory processes, to prevent the inclusion of state agency administrative fees in certain economic development grants, and to repeal the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's authority to establish stream channel encroachment lines and issue permits for encroachments upon or uses and activities within them.
