Title: AN ACT CONCERNING STANDING TO APPEAL A ZONING DECISION AND ESTABLISHING CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF MUNICIPAL BLIGHT ORDINANCES.

Statement of Purpose: To: (1) Limit appeals of certain zoning decisions to an aggrieved person who owns land in this state, and clarify that an "aggrieved person", in the case of a decision by a zoning commission, planning commission, combined planning and zoning commission or zoning board of appeals, includes a person who owns land that abuts or is within one hundred feet of the land involved in the decision, provided such person's land is within this state; and (2) grant municipalities general power to obtain a search warrant in order to enforce municipal ordinances, regulations and other administration or enforcement powers granted by statute.
