Substitute Senate Bill No. 268

Senate, April 3, 2012

The Committee on General Law reported through SEN. DOYLE of the 9th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT REQUIRING RETAILERS TO DISCLOSE SPECIFIC ABSORPTION RATES FOR CELLULAR TELEPHONES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of
2 Consumer Protection, in consultation with the Commissioner of Public
3 Health, shall issue a notice detailing recommended best practices for
4 the safe use of cellular mobile telephone devices. Such notice shall be
5 posted on the Department of Consumer Protection's Internet web site.
6 For purposes of this section, "cellular mobile telephone device" means
7 a portable wireless telephone device that is designed to send or receive
8 transmissions through a cellular radiotelephone service, as defined in
9 47 CFR 22.99.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
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GL *Joint Favorable Subst.*

AN ACT REQUIRING RETAILERS TO DISCLOSE SPECIFIC ABSORPTION RATES FOR CELLULAR TELEPHONES.

SUMMARY:

This bill requires the Department of Consumer Protection (DCP) commissioner, in consultation with the public health commissioner, to issue a notice detailing the recommended best practices for the safe use of cell phones, which are portable wireless telephone devices that are designed to send or receive transmissions through cellular radiotelephone service, as defined in federal regulations (47 CFR 22.99).

The notice must be posted on the DCP website.
