"AN ACT AUTHORIZING BOW AND ARROW HUNTING ON SUNDAY UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (d) of section 53a-217e of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2012*):

6 (d) (1) A person is guilty of negligent hunting in the third degree
7 when such person, while hunting, (A) discharges a firearm at a time of
8 day when hunting is not permitted, (B) discharges a firearm from a
9 vehicle, (C) hunts while the person's license to hunt is suspended, (D)
10 hunts out of season or on a Sunday by any means other than with bow
11 and arrow pursuant to section 26-73, as amended by this act, or (E)
12 discharges a firearm so as to cause the projectile to strike or enter into
13 any building occupied by people or domestic animals or used for
14 storage of flammable or combustible materials.

15 (2) Negligent hunting in the third degree is a class B misdemeanor
16 and any person found guilty under subdivision (1) of this subsection
17 shall be fined not less than two hundred dollars."
