"AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF ORGANIC PESTICIDES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL REGULATION OF THE USE OF PESTICIDES ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) On and after October 1,
4 2013, no person shall introduce any product containing methoprene
5 (isopropyl(2E-4E)-11-methoxy-3,7,11-trimethyl-2,4-dodecadienoate)
6 into any catch basin, brook, stream, river, lake, pond, sound or any
7 other body of water, except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of
8 this section.

9 (b) Methoprene may be introduced into a catch basin, brook, stream,
10 river, lake, pond, sound or any other body of water if the
11 Commissioner of Public Health declares a public health emergency
12 related to a life-threatening, mosquito-borne illness.

13 (c) Any application of methoprene permitted pursuant to subsection
14 (b) of this section shall be performed only by a duly licensed applicator
15 and in accordance with the federal Clean Water Act (33 USC 1251 et
16 seq.).

17 (d) Any person who wilfully violates any provision of this section
18 shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor."
