1 After line 61, insert the following:

2 "(e) Not later than thirty days following the receipt of the report
3 submitted to the General Assembly pursuant to subsection (d) of this
4 section, any member of the General Assembly may present to the clerk
5 of the member's chamber, who shall present the same to the Legislative
6 Commissioners' Office, a written petition requesting preparation of a
7 resolution based on the report submitted pursuant to subsection (d) of
8 this section. The petition shall be jointly sponsored by members of the
9 House of Representatives and the Senate and shall be signed in the
10 original by at least fifty-one members of the House of Representatives
11 and by at least twelve members of the Senate. The Legislative
12 Commissioners' Office shall prepare the recommendations contained
13 in the report in resolution form and shall forward the resolution to the
14 clerk of the chamber of origin, as determined by the speaker of the
15 House and the president pro tempore of the Senate, for processing and

16 placement on the calendar. The General Assembly shall either adopt or
17 reject the resolution prior to May first of the year in which the report
18 was submitted, except that if the General Assembly fails to adopt or
19 reject the resolution prior to May first of the year in which the report
20 was submitted, then, notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (e)
21 of this section, the recommendations contained in such resolution shall
22 be deemed rejected and shall not become effective."
