"AN ACT CONCERNING THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR CANDIDATES SEEKING ELECTION TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL."

1 Strike lines 1 to 12, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 3-124 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 (a) There shall be an Attorney General to be elected in the same
6 manner as other state officers in accordance with the provisions of
7 section 9-181. The Attorney General shall; [be]

8 (1) Be an elector of this state; [and]

9 (2) Be an attorney at law [of at least ten years' active practice at the
10 bar of this state. The office of the Attorney General shall be at the
11 Capitol.] who has been a member of the bar of this state for a
12 continuous period of at least ten years immediately prior to taking
13 office; and

14 (3) Have at least ten years' experience lawfully performing duties in
15 this state or in any other jurisdiction which only an attorney admitted
16 in this state or such other jurisdiction may lawfully perform.

17 (b) The Attorney General shall receive an annual salary of one
18 hundred ten thousand dollars. The Attorney General shall devote full
19 time to the duties of the office and shall give bond in the sum of ten
20 thousand dollars."
