**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE POWERS OF CERTAIN AGENTS
AND OFFICERS OF THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2012*) No sworn special agent
4 or sworn uniformed division officer of the United States Secret Service
5 shall exercise the authority granted, or be entitled to the defenses
6 provided, in sections 53a-19, 53a-22 and 53a-23 of the general statutes,
7 as amended by this act, and section 4 of this act, unless such agent or
8 officer has satisfactorily completed at least ten hours of training
9 provided by the Police Officer Standards and Training Council for the
10 purposes of learning protocols and procedures of Connecticut law
11 enforcement in order to prevent jurisdictional conflicts, potential issues
12 concerning the use of firearms and other related problems."
