**"AN ACT CREATING A PROCESS FOR FAMILY CHILD CARE PROVIDERS AND PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANTS TO COLLECTIVELY BARGAIN WITH THE STATE."**

1      Strike lines 196 to 219, inclusive, in their entirety, and insert the  
2      following in lieu thereof:

3      "(5) Three appointed by the Governor one of whom shall be a  
4      consumer with a developmental disability recommended by the Office  
5      of Protection and Advocacy for Persons with Disabilities, one of whom  
6      shall be a consumer with a physical disability recommended by the  
7      Officer of Protection and Advocacy for Persons with Disabilities, and  
8      one of whom shall be an elderly consumer recommended by the  
9      Commission on Aging;

10      (6) One appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives  
11      who shall be a consumer with a developmental disability  
12      recommended by the Council on Developmental Disabilities;

13      (7) One appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate who

14 shall be a consumer with a physical disability recommended by the  
15 Independent Living Council;

16 (8) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of  
17 Representatives who shall be an elderly consumer recommended by  
18 the Long-Term Care Advisory Council;

19 (9) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate who shall be  
20 a consumer with a developmental disability recommended by the  
21 Brain Injury Association of Connecticut;

22 (10) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of  
23 Representatives who shall be a consumer with a physical disability  
24 recommended by the Connecticut Council for Persons with  
25 Disabilities; and

26 (11) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate who shall  
27 be an elderly consumer recommended by the Long-Term Care  
28 Ombudsman."
