**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any  
4 provision of law, the provisions of sections 1 to 17, inclusive, of this  
5 act, section 19 of this act and subsection (e) of section 21a-243 of the  
6 general statutes, as amended by this act, shall not be effective until the  
7 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance  
8 of matters relating to the judiciary receives written notice from the  
9 United States Attorney for the District of Connecticut that the office of  
10 such United States Attorney will not prosecute a dispensary licensed  
11 under section 9 of this act or a producer licensed under section 10 of  
12 this act, or any employee thereof, who is in compliance with the  
13 provisions of sections 1 to 17, inclusive, of this act."
