**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TOLLS FOR
THE EXTENSION OF ROUTE 11."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Transportation
4 shall conduct (1) a study to determine: The cost of extending Route 11
5 from Salem to I-95; the cost of establishing tolls on such extension and
6 the estimated revenue from such tolls; the estimated period of time
7 required for the collection of toll revenue in an amount equal to the
8 cost of establishing such tolls; and the estimated additional period of
9 time required for the collection of toll revenue in an amount equal to
10 the cost of such extension, and (2) a survey of property owners
11 surrounding Route 11 and the area to which Route 11 may be extended
12 that determines such property owners' views on the possible extension
13 and the potential impact on their lives. On or before January 15, 2013,
14 the department shall submit, in accordance with section 11-4a of the
15 general statutes, the results of such study and survey to the joint

16 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
17 matters relating to transportation."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
