"AN ACT CONCERNING TEACHER CERTIFICATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (e) of section 10a-105 of the 2012 supplement to
4 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2012*):

6 (e) Said board of trustees shall waive the payment of tuition fees at
7 The University of Connecticut (1) for any dependent child of a person
8 (A) whom the armed forces of the United States has declared to be
9 missing in action or to have been a prisoner of war while serving in
10 such armed forces after January 1, 1960, (B) who was killed in action
11 while performing active military duty with the armed forces of the
12 United States, or (C) who has served or is serving in the armed forces
13 of the United States and has a disability rating of one hundred per
14 cent, as determined by the Veterans' Administration of the United

15 States, which child has been accepted for admission to The University
16 of Connecticut and is a resident of Connecticut at the time such child is
17 accepted for admission to said institution, (2) subject to the provisions
18 of subsection (f) of this section, for any veteran who performed service
19 in time of war, as defined in subsection (a) of section 27-103, except
20 that for purposes of this subsection, "service in time of war" shall not
21 include time spent in attendance at a military service academy, who
22 has been accepted for admission to said institution and is domiciled in
23 this state at the time such veteran is accepted for admission to said
24 institution, (3) for any resident of Connecticut sixty-two years of age or
25 older who has been accepted for admission to said institution,
26 provided (A) such person is enrolled in a degree-granting program, or
27 (B) at the end of the regular registration period, there are enrolled in
28 the course a sufficient number of students other than those persons
29 eligible for waivers pursuant to this subdivision to offer the course in
30 which such person intends to enroll and there is space available in
31 such course after accommodating all such students, (4) for any active
32 member of the Connecticut Army or Air National Guard who (A) has
33 been certified by the Adjutant General or such Adjutant General's
34 designee as a member in good standing of the guard, and (B) is
35 enrolled or accepted for admission to said institution on a full-time or
36 part-time basis in an undergraduate or graduate degree-granting
37 program, (5) for any dependent child of a (A) police officer, as defined
38 in section 7-294a, or supernumerary or auxiliary police officer, (B)
39 firefighter, as defined in section 7-323j, or member of a volunteer fire
40 company, (C) municipal employee, or (D) state employee, as defined in
41 section 5-154, killed in the line of duty, (6) for any resident of the state
42 who is the dependent child or surviving spouse of a specified terrorist
43 victim who was a resident of the state, (7) for any dependent child of a
44 resident of the state who was killed in a multivehicle crash at or near
45 the intersection of Routes 44 and 10 and Nod Road in Avon on July 29,
46 2005, and (8) for any resident of the state who is a dependent child or
47 surviving spouse of a person who was killed in action while
48 performing active military duty with the armed forces of the United
49 States on or after September 11, 2001, and who was a resident of this

50 state. If any person who receives a tuition waiver in accordance with
51 the provisions of this subsection also receives educational
52 reimbursement from an employer, such waiver shall be reduced by the
53 amount of such educational reimbursement. Veterans described in
54 subdivision (2) of this subsection and members of the National Guard
55 described in subdivision (4) of this subsection shall be given the same
56 status as students not receiving tuition waivers in registering for
57 courses at The University of Connecticut. Notwithstanding the
58 provisions of section 10a-30, as used in this subsection, "domiciled in
59 this state" includes domicile for less than one year."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
