"AN ACT CONCERNING THE HUNTING OF DEER WITH A HANDGUN."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2012*) Any special officers
4 appointed as constables for fish and game protection pursuant to
5 section 26-6a of the general statutes by any town in Hartford County
6 having a population of more than forty-four thousand but less than
7 fifty thousand as determined by the most recent decennial census shall
8 be exempt from the provisions of section 7-294d of the general statutes,
9 provided such constables successfully complete a basic police training
10 course that is tailored to the duties to be performed by such officers
11 and provided by a police officer of the police department of such town
12 who is certified under the provisions of subsection (a) of section 7-294d
13 of the general statutes. In order to carry a firearm in the course of their
14 duties, such officers shall be certified by a firearms trainer of such

15 police department and comply with the same requirements for
16 periodic recertification that are applicable to regular sworn members
17 of such department."
