"AN ACT CONCERNING CHEMICALS OF CONCERN TO CHILDREN."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 15, 2013, the
4 Commissioner of Public Health shall, within available appropriations
5 and in consultation with the Commissioner of Correction and the
6 Chemical Innovations Institute within The University of Connecticut
7 Health Center, established pursuant to section 22a-903 of the general
8 statutes, submit a report in accordance with the provisions of section
9 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of the
10 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public
11 health, judiciary, the environment and consumer protection
12 concerning the regulation of chemicals used by the state to inflict the
13 punishment of death. Such report shall include, but shall not be limited
14 to: (1) A list of chemicals used to inflict the punishment of death
15 pursuant to section 54-100 of the general statutes; (2) a description of

16 the methods of storage, security, transport and disposal of such
17 chemicals; (3) identification of the expiration dates of such chemicals;
18 (4) a description of the effectiveness of such chemicals; (5) a list of
19 chemicals used in other states for the purpose of inflicting the
20 punishment of death; (6) a description of any study conducted by a
21 governmental entity or private organization concerning any chemical
22 identified pursuant to subdivision (1) of this section; (7) identification
23 of any ban or limitation on the use of any such chemical; and (8) any
24 other information the commissioner deems relevant."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
