1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 4 of public act 10-124 is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 268 of the general
6 statutes, [for two years from the effective date of this section,] any
7 person who holds a current passenger-for-hire license issued by the
8 United States Coast Guard and a current charter boat registration
9 issued by the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection
10 pursuant to section 26-142a of the general statutes shall not be
11 prohibited from operating a vessel registered with a marine [dealer's]
12 dealer registration number issued pursuant to section 15-145 of the
13 general statutes, provided any such person [has operated] operates a
14 recreational charter fishing guide service using a vessel registered with

15 such a marine [dealer's] dealer registration number in connection with
16 such guide service, [for not less than five of the ten years preceding the
17 effective date of this section.]

18 (b) The Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection
19 shall not revoke a marine [dealer's] dealer registration number issued
20 pursuant to section 15-145 of the general statutes for any vessel used in
21 compliance with subsection (a) of this section."
