"AN ACT CONCERNING CHEMICALS OF CONCERN TO CHILDREN."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 15, 2013, the
4 Commissioner of Public Health, the Commissioner of Consumer
5 Protection, the Commissioner of Mental Health and Addiction
6 Services, the Commissioner of Education and the Commissioner of
7 Emergency Services and Public Protection shall, within available
8 appropriations, jointly report, in accordance with the provisions of
9 section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of
10 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public
11 health, consumer protection, human services, education and public
12 safety concerning the regulation of certain chemicals in the state. Such
13 report shall include, but not be limited to: (1) A list of chemicals that
14 are present in marijuana or used in the commercial cultivation of

15 marijuana; (2) an evaluation of the effect of such chemicals on the
16 health of children; (3) a description of the change in the frequency that
17 services have been provided by the Department of Mental Health and
18 Addiction Services relating to the abuse of marijuana after the passage
19 of public act 11-71 decriminalizing possession of small amounts of
20 marijuana; (4) a description of the change in the rate of school
21 suspensions relating to the use of marijuana after the passage of said
22 public act; and (5) an evaluation of the effects of decriminalization of
23 marijuana in other states on the provision of mental health and
24 addiction services and school suspension rates."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
