"AN ACT ADOPTING THE UNIFORM ELECTRONIC LEGAL MATERIAL ACT AND THE UNIFORM CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR VESSELS ACT."

1 Strike lines 223 and 224 in their entirety and insert the following in
2 lieu thereof:

3 "(29) "Title brand" means a designation of previous damage, use or
4 condition that is set forth on a certificate of title issued by another state
5 or other statement which shall be indicated on a certificate of title in
6 accordance with the provisions of section 20 of this act and any
7 regulations adopted by the commissioner under section 40 of this act;"

8 In line 234, strike ", paddle or oar", after the semi-colon insert "(D)
9 Watercraft propelled solely by paddle or oar;" and renumber the
10 remaining subparagraphs and internal references accordingly

11 After line 362, insert the following and renumber the remaining
12 subdivisions and internal references accordingly:

13 "(8) Any title brand known to the applicant and, if known, the
14 jurisdiction under whose law the title brand was created;"

15 In line 443, strike "and"

16 After line 443, insert the following in lieu thereof and renumber the
17 remaining the subdivision and internal references accordingly:

18 "(7) All title brands indicated in the files of the department covering
19 the vessel, including, but not limited to, brands indicated on a
20 certificate created by a governmental agency of another jurisdiction
21 and delivered to the department; and"

22 After line 447, insert the following and reletter the remaining
23 subsections and internal references accordingly:

24 "(c) For each title brand indicated on a certificate of title, the
25 certificate shall identify the jurisdiction under whose law the title
26 brand was created or the jurisdiction that created the certificate on
27 which the title brand was indicated. If the meaning of a title brand is
28 not easily ascertainable or cannot be accommodated on the certificate,
29 the certificate may state: "Previously branded in (insert the jurisdiction
30 under whose law the title brand was created or whose certificate of
31 title previously indicated the title brand)."

32 In line 475, after "title," insert "all title brands known to the
33 department,"

34 In line 888, strike "or termination statement" and insert in lieu
35 thereof ", termination statement or title brand"
