"AN ACT CONCERNING SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAMS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (c) of section 30-86 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2012*):

6 (c) (1) [A] As a condition for selling or delivering alcoholic liquor, a
7 permittee or permittee's agent or employee [may] shall perform a
8 transaction scan to check the validity of a driver's license or identity
9 card or a document described in subdivision (3) of this subsection
10 presented by a [cardholder as a condition for selling, giving away or
11 otherwise distributing alcoholic liquor to the cardholder] person.

12 (2) If the information deciphered by the transaction scan performed
13 under subdivision (1) of this subsection fails to match the information
14 printed on the driver's license, [or] identity card or document
15 presented by the [cardholder] person, or if the transaction scan

16 indicates that the information so printed is false or fraudulent, neither
 17 the permittee nor any permittee's agent or employee shall sell, give
 18 away or otherwise distribute any alcoholic liquor to the [cardholder]
 19 person.

20 (3) Subdivision (1) of this subsection does not preclude a permittee
 21 or permittee's agent or employee from using a transaction scan device
 22 to check the validity of a document presented as identification (1) other
 23 than a driver's license or an identity card, if the document includes a
 24 bar code or magnetic strip that may be scanned by the device, as a
 25 condition for selling, giving away or otherwise distributing alcoholic
 26 liquor to the person presenting the document, or (2) as a condition for
 27 giving away or otherwise distributing alcoholic liquor to any person."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
