**"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE STATE BUDGET  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2012."**

1 Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (c) of section 203 in its entirety  
2 and insert the following in lieu thereof:

3 "(c) (1) An eligible small business may apply to the department for a  
4 grant to subsidize on-the-job training and compensation for a new  
5 employee, where "new employee" means a person who (A) was  
6 unemployed immediately prior to employment, regardless of whether  
7 such person collected unemployment compensation benefits as a result  
8 of such unemployment, and (B) [is a resident of a municipality that has  
9 (i) an unemployment rate that is equal to or higher than the state  
10 unemployment rate as of September 1, 2011, or (ii) a population of  
11 eighty thousand or more, and (C)] has a family income equal to or less  
12 than two hundred fifty per cent of the federal poverty level, adjusted  
13 for family size. "New employee" does not include a person who was  
14 employed in this state by a related person with respect to the eligible  
15 small business during the prior twelve months or a person employed

16 on a temporary or seasonal basis by a retailer, as defined in section 42-  
17 371."
