**Re: "Issuance of Driver's License with Restrictions"  
Regulation No: 2012-16**

Dear Senator Roraback and Representative Davis:

On June 26, 2012, the above-referenced regulation was "Rejected Without Prejudice" by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee. As such, pursuant to the recommendations of and consultation with the Legislative Commissioner's Office, the Department of Motor Vehicles ("the Department") has made the necessary changes to the regulation.

On page 1, in "B" and "D", and on page 2, in "U", the phrase "such licensee is" was inserted before "using", for clarity.

On page 1, in "C" and "E" and "F", the phrase "such motor vehicles" was inserted before "equipped", for clarity.

On page 1, in "K", the phrase "in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b) of section 14-44e of the Connecticut General Statutes" was deleted due to its repeal and replaced with the proper federal citation for accuracy: "as authorized in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, section 383.153(a) (10)". Federal law allows a state variance for persons to operate on an intrastate basis. In addition, the following clarifying language was added to the sentence: "including, but not limited to, all licensees who are eighteen years of age or older but younger than twenty-one years of age".

On page 2, in "V", the reference of "383.153(e)" was inadvertently added to the proposal during its drafting. This federal citation does not pertain to any medical


variance for commercial driver's license ("CDL") holders, and is inconsistent with the newly established "V" restriction. As such, it has been removed for clarity and accuracy.

On page 2, in "W", "and/or" has been changed to "or" for proper form.

Therefore, in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b) of Section 4-170 of the Connecticut General Statutes, this is to advise the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the Department's resubmission of the regulation concerning "Issuance of Driver's License with Restrictions."

Please find enclosed the original proposed regulation. An electronic copy has also been submitted.
