Notice of Intent to Amend Regulation

In accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to section 14-36a (b) and 14-36(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to amend the regulation regarding "Issuance of Driver's License with Restrictions, Section 14-36a-2."

Statement of purpose: The purpose of the amendment of this regulation is to clarify and enumerate the list of possible restrictions that may be used to limit the scope of an operator's use of a vehicle in the State of Connecticut.
