RE: Limitations on Non-emergency Dental Services Provided to Medicaid Clients


Dear Senator Roraback and Representative Davis:

Pursuant to subsection (b) of § 4-170 of the Connecticut General Statutes, I am submitting for your approval a proposed regulation to establish limitations on the extent of non-emergency dental services provided to Medicaid clients twenty-one years of age and older.

The proposed regulation implements the provisions of Public Act 11-44, § 81 and Public Act 11-61, § 158, now codified at §17b-282d of the Connecticut General Statutes, which requires the department to modify the extent of non-emergency adult dental services under the Medicaid program. These changes are designed to reduce excessive dental procedures while maintaining services that will prevent further disease, decrease emergency department use and continue the maintenance of appropriate oral health for adult Medicaid clients.

Notice of the proposed regulation was published in the Connecticut Law Journal on August 2, 2011. A public hearing was held on August 31, 2011. On April 30, 2012, the Office of the Attorney General approved the proposed regulation as legally sufficient. A copy of the proposed regulation has been submitted to the Office of Fiscal Analysis.
