#### Notice of Intent to Amend Regulations

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.), notice is hereby given that the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD), under the authority of C.G.S. 10-416a, proposes to adopt amended regulations concerning tax credits for the rehabilitation of historic commercial, industrial, institutional, former municipal, state or federal government property, cultural building or residential property of more than four units for residential use.

**Statement of purpose:** To establish amended DECD application requirements, standards and procedures for application review and approval to determine owner-eligibility for the historic tax credit voucher administered by the DECD under C.G.S. 10-416a.
