In accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to section 14-137 of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to amend a regulation regarding the "Requirements for Maintaining Federal Certification Label on Motor Vehicles with Manufacturer's Gross Vehicle Weight Rating of 10,001 Pounds or More."

The purpose of the proposed regulation is to ensure compliance with federal requirements set forth in 49 CFR Part 567 which provides that any motor vehicle with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of 10,001 pounds or more shall maintain the Federal Certification Label inside said motor vehicle.

Notice of Intent to Amend Regulations

In accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to section 14-37a of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to amend a regulation regarding the "Registration of Permitted Overweight Vehicle."

The purpose of the proposed regulation is to address applicants who apply for an overweight vehicle permit from the Department of Transportation. Currently, after making said application to the Department of Transportation, the registration issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles is deemed to be a temporary registration, at the gross vehicle weight stated in the permit issued by the Department of Transportation, for a period of ten (10) days. The amended regulation requires that the registration issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles, which is a permanent registration, reflects a gross vehicle weight that is equal to or greater than that stated in the overweight vehicle permit issued by the Department of Transportation.
