Re: Proposed Regulations Concerning Continuing Education for Electricians

Dear Attorney McDonald:

The Department of Consumer Protection is seeking to modify the regulations concerning Continuing Education for Electricians. The authority for these regulations is Connecticut General Statutes Section 20-334d, as modified by Section 1 of Public Act No. 2011-247:

Pursuant to Sec. 4-168(b), I am writing to notify you that the Department required additional time to publish notice of our intent to amend said regulations. Notice was published in the Connecticut Law Journal on May 1, 2012. The Department required this additional time to ensure accuracy and compliance with the underlying statute.

This proposed regulation modifies the continuing education requirements for individuals to maintain an electrical license. The Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing of the Department of Consumer Protection has jurisdiction over this subject area.
