

The analysis and discussion so far has missed one of the most significant objections to DEEP's proposed plan to turn to natural gas as a substitute for oil.

There is an insurmountable cost of natural gas that is not considered anywhere in DEEP's Strategy.

One way to clarify this...immediate...extreme cost of turning to natural gas to replace oil would be the following. If we are to import natural gas from deposits in PA or NY or wherever, we should also be forced to import our proportional share of fracking waste for storage. If we were to consider burdening ourselves with this cost of natural gas instead of letting it be shoved off on citizens in farmland elsewhere, I think people would turn away, and would insist on sustainable alternatives.
