The Committee on Children reported through REP. URBAN of the 43rd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING DISSECTION CHOICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2013*) A local or regional school
- 2 district shall excuse any student from participating in, or observing,
- 3 the dissection of any animal as part of classroom instruction if such
- 4 student has requested, in writing, to be excused from such
- 5 participation or observation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
