House Bill No. 6587

House of Representatives, April 24, 2013

The Committee on Judiciary reported through REP. FOX, G. of the 146th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACTS BETWEEN THE STATE AND ANY MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY IS LOCATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The legislative body of any
2 municipality in which a correctional facility is located that is under the
3 supervision of the Commissioner of Correction and is owned or leased
4 by the state may seek and obtain an amendment to any contract related
5 to the correctional facility that is in effect between the municipality and
6 a state agency. For the purposes of this section, "municipality" means a
7 town, city or consolidated town and borough.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Explanation

The bill allows municipalities to seek and obtain an addendum to certain contracts with correctional facilities owned or leased by the state. The fiscal impact to the Department of Correction and municipalities is uncertain as any costs or savings would depend on contract negotiations.

This bill specifically allows a municipal legislative body to seek and obtain an amendment to a contract that (1) is currently in effect between the municipality and a state agency and (2) relates to a correctional facility within the municipality that is owned or leased by the state and supervised by the Department of Correction (DOC) commissioner.
