The Committee on Appropriations reported through SEN. HARP of the 10th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2013*) The Commissioner of Correction
2 shall review the programs administered by the Department of
3 Correction in order to: (1) Evaluate the cost-effectiveness and benefits
4 of such programs, and (2) assign priority for the continued funding of
5 such programs. The commissioner shall submit, in accordance with
6 section 11-4a of the general statutes, findings and recommendations to
7 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
8 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of
9 state agencies not later than January 1, 2014.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
