Dear Senator Musto, Representative Jutila, Senator McLachlan, Representative Hwang and members of the Government Administration and Elections Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity today to testify in support of **House Bill No. 6672 AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN PARCELS OF STATE LAND.**

This bill would transfer a parcel of land approximately 45 acres in size to the town of Southbury. That land could then be transferred to Southbury Elderly Housing, Inc. to help develop new subsidized low income senior housing.

Currently, there is a long waiting list for existing senior housing in Southbury. In this difficult economy, and with a high concentration of citizens over the age of 65, this bill would mean a prudent plan is in place to provide housing options for seniors in town in Southbury.

While this land is currently a part of the campus of the Southbury Training School, it is important to note that this bill would not interfere with the function of the School. The parcel in question has already been scheduled to be completely closed down in the near future, so this bill will simply allow the town to respond to its senior housing needs.

Thank you again for allowing me to testify on this bill and for considering this legislation.
